

HOW TO APPLY FOR MUNSTER TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY (MTU) - KERRY CAMPUS SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP AWARD FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021/2022

FIRST YEAR (CAO) APPLICANTS TO THE UNIVERSITY

2. Apply for your MTU (Kerry Campus) chosen course through the Central Applications Office (CAO) system. Confirmation of your application to CAO must accompany the scholarship application. If you use the Change of Mind facility via CAO, you must also inform MTU (Kerry Campus) of your new course choice list. (You need only specify the MTU Kerry Campus) courses that you have applied for).

Scholarship Applicants must meet a common minimum cut-off point for all programmes:

Higher Certificate (Level 6) - minimum requirements	130 points
Ordinary Degree (Level 7) - minimum requirements	150 points
Honours Degree (Level 8) - minimum requirements	200 points

Note: There are two places in total reserved for TL890 BSc (Hons) in General Nursing/TL891 BSc (Hons) in Mental Health Nursing for applicants who are within 60 points of the Leaving Certificate cut off points.

HIGHER CERTIFICATE (LEVEL 6) MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must achieve a pass in the Leaving Certificate or equivalent examination, obtaining a minimum of O6/H7 in English OR Irish, O6/H7 in Maths or a minimum grade of F2 in Foundation Level Maths (in specified courses only) and O6/H7 in three other subjects.

Note: Please check our prospectus or website at www.ittralee.ie to ascertain where Foundation Level Maths at F2 is accepted for level 6 and level 7 programmes.

ORDINARY DEGREE (LEVEL 7) MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must achieve a pass in the Leaving Certificate or equivalent examination, obtaining a minimum of O6/H7 in English OR Irish, O6/H7 in Maths or a minimum grade of F2 in Foundation Level Maths (in specified courses) and O6/H7 in three other subjects.

Note: Please check our prospectus or website at www.ittralee.ie to ascertain where Foundation Level Maths at F2 is accepted for level 6 and level 7 programmes.

HONOURS DEGREE (LEVEL 8) MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must achieve a pass in the Leaving Certificate or equivalent, obtaining two H5 and four 4 x O6/H7. Candidates are required to obtain a minimum of O6/H7 in English OR Irish and Mathematics.
