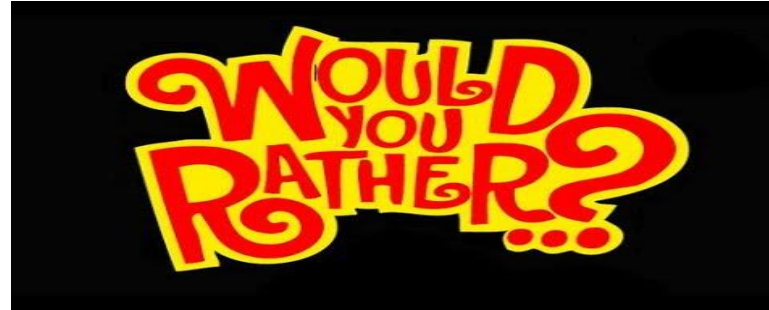

Like Banagrams but with sums! Any easy one to recreate at home for free!

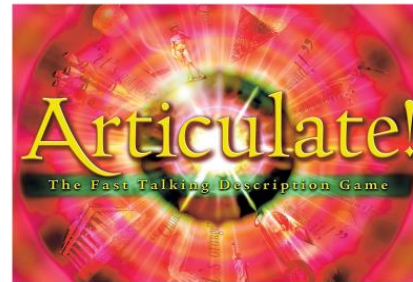

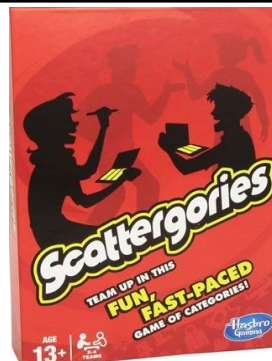


Numeracy is not just about numbers - draughts helps with lots of numeracy skills, is easy to learn and fun for everyone! You can also play in person or online!
