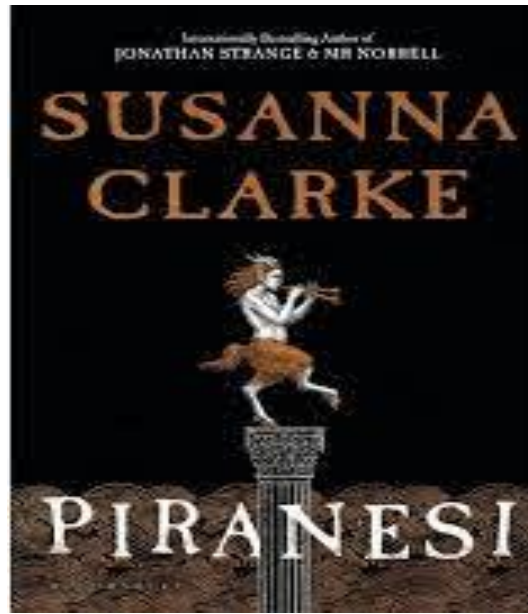


BOOK CLUB!

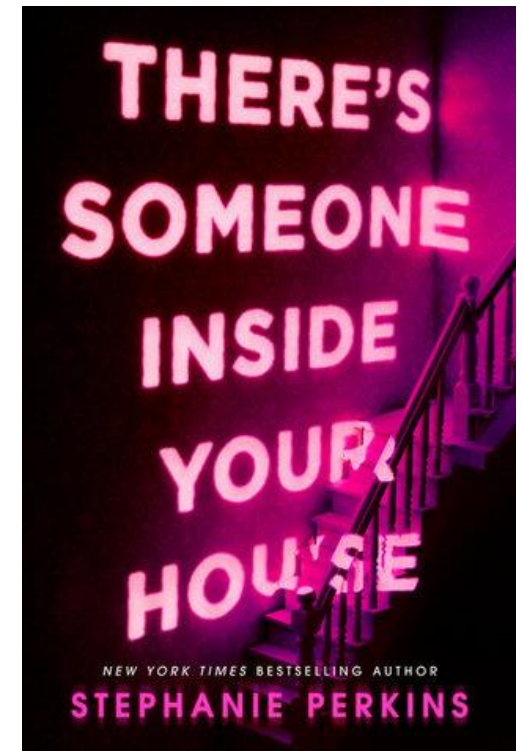
