Aughinish Alumina is recruiting First Year Apprentices to start in **Autumn 2021**. Each apprenticeship is for a period of four years (or for a period determined by the Standards Based Apprenticeship Scheme)

Those appointed will receive full training in their craft both onsite in Aughinish and in College

The Requirements

Candidates, male or female, must be 17 years of age by 31st August 2021

To join the MAMF or EI Apprentice programme, SOLAS require that applicants pass the Ishihara Colour Vision Test 24 plate edition

Requirements



Minimum Qualifications:

- Grade D1/H5/O5 in five subjects in the **Established Leaving Certificate** examination – must include **Maths and English**
- Persons already serving an Apprenticeship **are not** eligible

- Persons sitting their Leaving Certificate in 2021 **are** eligible. Results can be forwarded when available
